Following points were discussed:

Director reviewed the previous DAB meeting resolutions made and the achievement of those resolutions in the last semester.

The following discussions and resolutions were made in the current meeting.

As Proposed by the Programme Assessment Committee, the following actions are planned and discussed by the Department Advisory Board

- i. To improve the quality of the curriculum, it is decided to maintain strong attendance, high quality projects, student research publication and incorporation of Zoho office automation tools with our syllabus is proposed. Industry representatives also advised the committee to have a robust curriculum with industry standard projects. He also suggested the students submit a day to day report about their internship in college.
- ii .To increase the quality of the teaching fraternity, it is planned to conduct a minimum of 2 FDP, 2 MDP and 3 EDP. It is also advised to the teaching fraternity to develop collaborations with premier institutions through FDP, Conference and other consulting work.
- iii.Students and faculty members are encouraged to register as Startups and also encouraged to apply for new projects and idea funding. This is planned in the aspect of developing entrepreneurial culture among students.
- iv. Faculty members are encouraged to apply for national level funding and also to apply for FDP, Conference funding through ICSSR, IEEE and other forums.
- v.It is also decided to improve placement performance by 70%. Industry experts and Alumni members suggested having regular placement training through weekly quizzes, resume writing and other activities.
- vi. The course outcomes and their mapping with program outcomes were reviewed. .
- vii. Students membership in IEEE and MMA should be encouraged and also society based activities are proposed for students' involvement.
